I have received your letter of June 16, 1998

I do not know how you obtained a dismissal of the DUI charge at the time of the Preliminary Hearing. Given these facts, and given the reckless manner in which your client operated his motorcycle, I am not sympathetic to your client's assertion that a conviction of possession of marijuana will result in a license suspension. In fact, it is my belief that a license suspension would be appropriate given your client's conduct.

Accordingly, I will not agree to drop the possession of marijuana charge and have your client plead guilty to possession of drug paraphernalia. If you wish to take this matter to trial as a result of the above decision, please feel free to do so.
